#### ELIGIBILITY

This series is open to all boats that meet the CRCA Class Rules and compete in a CRCA Class. To be eligible for the Annapolis Trophy you must:

1. Be a **Full** member of CRCA.
2. Have a current **EZ** certificate for your boat.

#### CLASSES

The events included in this series are scored by CRCA class. There will be trophies for CRCA Cruiser, CRCA Racer, and CRCA Performance classes.

#### SCORING

1. A custom series scoring method designed to encourage performance and participation will be used. The total score for the series is based upon a combination of 50% performance, and 50% participation.
2. The best three (3) races based upon the performance score of individual races will be used.

3. A boat's final score will be a combination of the best three (3) races for the performance component plus all races raced in for participation component. A boat will gain by competing in more races. Details of the scoring method are contained in the CRCA Series Scoring Method under Documents on the CRCA website ([sailcrca.org](http://sailcrca.org)).
